### **YOUR TRAINING EXPERIENCE WILL INCLUDE:**

- \* **The Realities Of Today's Gunfights:** We will review and analyze current law enforcement gunfight statistics, plus the physical and mental responses to combat stress. We will then determine how the results should shape your firearms training standards, practices, and policies.
- \* **Qualification vs. Training:** Are there differences between the two? What are they? Learn why an understanding of these issues is so important, and why you do not have to settle for one or the other.
- \* **Legal and Financial Consequences of Inadequate Training:** We will examine the court cases, decisions, and monetary awards that should shape your current training liability policy.
- \* **Shooting Range Design:** We will discuss critical issues relating to the planning and construction of indoor and outdoor shooting ranges. This discussion is applicable to not only new range projects, but to current range upgrades and expansion as well.
